Singing River Electric Cooperative Application for Membership and Service Agreement

By requesting electric service, the Applicant hereby applies for membership and agrees to purchase electric energy from Singing River Electric Cooperative (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Applicant agrees to pay the Cooperative a membership fee and a connection charge. A refundable deposit may be necessary to guarantee payment of service charges.
- 2. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available and meter is installed, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises and will make payment thereof monthly at rates fixed by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative. The Applicant will pay a minimum amount provided by the applicable rate schedule or contract per month regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed.
- 3. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the charter and bylaws of the Cooperative and such lawful rules and regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the Cooperative.
- 4. The Applicant hereby grants and conveys to the Cooperative all necessary easements and right-of-way on, over and across applicants property and gives and grants to the Cooperative, its agents, servants and employees the right to enter upon Applicant's property to the extent deemed reasonably necessary by the Cooperative.
- 5. Upon acceptance of this application by the Cooperative this instrument shall constitute the service agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative and shall continue in force and effect until canceled by either party. The Applicant hereby agrees to assume liability and to make payment for the following:
 - (a) The account for which electric power service is rendered by the Cooperative, pursuant to this application, at the locations for which this application forservice is made or any other account or indebtedness due to the Cooperative from the Applicant.
 - (b) Any delinquent account or amount owed to the Cooperative by anyone who while this application remains in force and effect shall live for any period of time at the location for which this application for service is made.

- (c) Any unauthorized adjustments or damage made to the Cooperative's facilities upon property owned by or occupied by the Applicant.
- (d) In the event of any delinquency in the account of applicant, applicant agrees to pay in addition to the amount owed, all reasonable and customary attorneys and/or collector's fees, not to exceed 50% of the amount owed plus all cost of court. Any obligations due the Cooperative will be set off against any capital credits assigned the Applicant.
